- 2) The application should be fully completed and duly signed by the Parents/Guardian of the Student.
- 3) The Parents/Guardian can apply for the Scholarship only after one year from their membership enrollment with the Sangha.
- 4) The application should be recommended by two persons, who should be the members of Sangha (As per below mentioned criteria), the said person cannot recommend more than two applications at a time.
 - Ⓐ One person should be a member of Sangha and residing near applicant's area.
 - Ⓑ One person should be a Managing Committee member of the Sangha.
- 5) Each application should accompanied the following:
 - Ⓐ Certified Copy of Mark sheet of previous annual examination which is attested by the respective School/College.
 - Ⓑ Certificate from the Principal confirming that he/she is a Bonafide Student of the Institute. i.e. Bonafide Certificate.
- 6) The Students Annual Examination marks should not be less than the 50%.
- 7) The Applicants annual family income should not exceed Rs. 1 Lakh.
- 8) The Managing Committee according to the availability of the funds will decide the scholarship amount from time to time.
- 9) Incomplete application forms will be rejected without prior information to the Applicant.
- 10) The Loan Scholarship, if sanctioned by the Sangha shall be repaid by the Student, immediately after completion of education and starts earning.
